

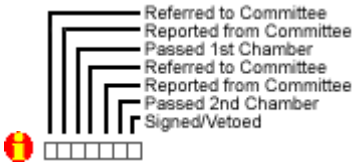

HR 19 Unsicker, Sarah(D) Urges state entities to engage in practices that encourage disability inclusion.
