

## How to Play

SADD-opoly is a yearlong challenge the encourages Missouri SADD chapters to move around the board, earning "dollars" for each space they complete. Each space on the board has a challenge that builds a more robust local SADD chapters, promotes community and civic engagement, and highlights participation in state and national programs.

The board moves in a chronological order to encompass the entire school year; each of the boards four sides represents a school quarter, making it easy to check off tasks along the way.

SADD chapters will receive stickers to mark off their completed tasks as they progress around the board. Eligibility to mark off a task requires a submission on the Missouri SADD chapter activity reporting form.

## Winning the Game & Prizes

SADD-opoly is all about learning prevention strategies while building a stronger SADD chapter and community support. In addition to all that is learned from SADD-opoly, participating chapters are also eligible for the prizes and recognition based on their dollars collected, with a prize awarded for dollars received each quarter, each semester, and over the entire year.
