# CONTEST DETAILS

## TIMELINE

### October 15

Digital artwork submission to ACT Missouri

### October 17

Submissions selected for live showcase will be notified

### October 22

Selected submissions must be mailed or delivered to Capital Arts

### October 26

In person art showcase in Jefferson City

### October 22-31

Art will be on display at Capital Arts for viewing

In partnership with the Capital Arts, ACT Missouri and Missouri SADD will host "The Art of Prevention," an evening of art and dialogue surrounding youth alcohol prevention efforts.

Greater Jefferson City area schools will be eligible to submit artwork developed by students based around the topic of youth alcohol prevention. Artwork images or recordings, along with a brief synopsis of the piece, will be submitted electronically in early October. Art may be physical (painting, drawing, etc), digital (graphic design, photography, etc), or verbal (music, poetry, dance, etc.). Pieces will be reviewed, with selected pieces being invited to join the community for a live art showcase at October 26 in Jefferson City from 6PM-8PM.

A panel of industry experts will converse with the artists of selected pieces at the live showcase, scoring each piece for "Best in Show" and "Best Use of Media" recognition. Community members will also select a "People's Choice" recognition.

## Rules

- Art must be student created.
- Students grades 3-12, as well as post-secondary, are eligible.
- Submissions may be individual or a team of up to three (3).
- Each piece of art should be focused around youth alcohol use prevention.
- There are no requirements for size, format, or media. Students are encouraged to create any piece of art they wish. Art, if selected, must be available to transport to Jefferson City and fit in a space no larger than 6'x6'x6'.
- A copy of art must be submitted digitally by October 15, 2021 at 11:59PM. For copies of physical work, a picture of the artwork is acceptable. For copies of verbal work, a recording is acceptable.
- Each submission must be accompanied by a cover sheet synopsis of the art, not exceeding 250 words. A template is provided online at [actmissouri.org](http://actmissouri.org)
